HOW THE POLL WAS CONDUCTED

This poll was conducted for Telemundo Station Group by Mason-Dixon Polling & Strategy, Inc. of Jacksonville, Florida from June 6 through June 11, 2019. A total of 400 registered Hispanic voters were interviewed statewide by telephone in Florida.

Those interviewed were randomly selected from a phone-matched Florida voter registration list that included both land-line and cell phone numbers. Quotas were assigned to reflect Hispanic voter registration by county.

The margin for error, according to standards customarily used by statisticians, is no more than ± 5 percentage points. This means that there is a 95 percent probability that the "true" figure would fall within that range if all Hispanic voters in Florida were surveyed. The margin for error is higher for any subgroup, such as a gender or age grouping.
