HOW THE POLL WAS CONDUCTED

This poll was conducted for Telemundo Station Group by Mason-Dixon Polling & Strategy, Inc. of Jacksonville, Florida from June 7 through June 13, 2019. A total of 400 registered Hispanic voters were interviewed statewide by telephone in the New York City metro area.

Those interviewed were randomly selected from a phone-matched voter registration lists that included both land-line and cell phone numbers. Quotas were assigned to reflect Hispanic voter registration by county.

The margin for error, according to standards customarily used by statisticians, is no more than ± 5 percentage points. This means that there is a 95 percent probability that the "true" figure would fall within that range if all Hispanic voters in the New York City metro area were surveyed. The margin for error is higher for any subgroup, such as a gender or age grouping.
