Student of the Month Contest
Official Rules
September 10, 2018 – December 2, 2018

PRELIMINARY INFORMATION: NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE OR WIN. PURCHASE OR PAYMENT WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

Void outside the KTMD terrestrial geographic viewing area and where prohibited. The Wingstop and Telemundo Houston Student of the Month Contest ("Contest") will begin on September 10, 2018 at 9:00 A.M. CT and end on December 2, 2018 at 11:59 P.M. CT ("Contest Period"). All times in the Contest refer to Central Time ("CT"). Contest is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws.

ELIGIBILITY: This contest is open only to permanent, legal U.S. residents who are physically located and residing in the terrestrial geographic viewing area of KTMD in the counties of Austin, Brazoria, Calhoun, Chambers, Colorado, Fort Bend, Galveston, Grimes, Harris, Jackson, Liberty, Matagorda, Montgomery, Polk, San Jacinto, Trinity, Walker, Waller, Washington, and Wharton in the state of Texas and who are at least eighteen (18) years of age or older as of the start of the Contest Period. Participation shall be conducted through a "nominator" and "nominee" process as detailed below.

Nominator: The nominator ("Nominator") must be eighteen (18) years of age or older as of September 10, 2018 and can be related (by blood or marriage) to the nominee or Nominator must be someone the nominee personally knows. Nominator must comply with all Contest eligibility requirements as set forth in these Official Rules.

Nominee: The nominee ("Nominee") must be a current student, in the 12th grade, in the Houston Independent School District. A Nominee can be someone that the Nominator is related to (by blood or marriage) or personally knows. Nominee must comply with all Contest eligibility requirements as set forth in these Official Rules.

Nominators and Nominees may not be at the time of nomination, and may not intend to be during six (6) months from the date of nomination, a candidate for any public office. Nominees and Nominators are collectively referred to herein as "Eligible Participants." Eligible Participants must have either a valid Social Security number and/or a valid U.S. personal taxpayer identification number. Officers, directors, and employees of Contest Entities (as defined below), members of these persons' immediate families (spouses, parents, children, and siblings, and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside), and/or persons living in the same households as such persons (whether related or not), are ineligible to enter or win a prize in the Contest. Contest Entities, as referenced herein, shall include the Sponsors (as defined below), Wingstop, Inc., 5501 Lyndon B Johnson Fwy. Dallas TX 75240-6225, and their respective parent, subsidiary, and affiliate companies, their administrative, advertising, and promotion agencies, and any other entity involved in the development, administration, promotion, or implementation of the Contest. The Sponsors of this Contest are KTMD-TV Telemundo Houston, 1235 North Loop West, Houston, TX 77008 and Telemundo Network Group LLC, 2350 N.W. 117th Place, Miami, FL 33182 (collectively "Sponsors").

TO PARTICPATE: The Contests consists of four (4) Individual Contests (each an "Individual Contest"), as detailed in the chart below and conducted during the Contest Period. Each Individual Contest will consist of: (i) a promotion period (an "Entry Period") as detailed in the chart below (each with a "Start Date" and an "End Date"); and (ii) an Individual Contest conducted on the

Individual Contest date (“Individual Contest Date”) specified in the chart below from among all eligible Entries received during the corresponding Entry Period. Entries for each Individual Contest must be received by the Entry Period End Date for the corresponding Entry Period as specified in the chart below. **Entries for the last Individual Contest (Individual Contest 4) must be received by 11:59 P.M. CT on December 2, 2018.**

The non-winning Entries for each Individual Contest will roll over to subsequent contests.

Access the Contest web site at www.telemundohouston.com/tu-telemundo/promociones (“Web Site”) and follow the onscreen instructions to complete and thereafter transmit the nomination form and essay. Information required on the nomination form includes **(a)** the following Nominator information: complete first and last name, zip code, telephone number (including area code), email address (which you must have prior to the start date of the Contest and maintain through the Contest Period and prize award period) (“Nominator Information”); and **(b)** the following Nominee information: Nominee’s first and last name, city, state, school name, telephone number of school (including area code) and email address (if available) (“Nominee Information”) Nominator Information and Nominee Information shall be referred to collectively as “Nomination Information”. If the Nominee featured in a Nomination is selected as the potential winner (as described below), both the Nominator and the Nominee may be required to provide additional information (including but not limited to, the nature of the relationship between the Nominator and Nominee (i.e. relative, school teacher, family friend, etc.). Nominator must also submit one (1) original essay (“Essay”) written in the English or Spanish language describing the Nominee’s personal traits and actions that demonstrate she is deserving of the Grand Prize and answers the following: Tell us about a time where your Nominee went above and beyond; How does your Nominee inspire others, and How is your Nominee involved in the community. The nomination form and Essay will together constitute a nomination in the Contest and shall be referred to collectively herein as the “Nomination”.

Nominators enter on behalf of the Nominee named in the Nomination. Nominators are not eligible to receive any prize. The prizes won by any minor will be awarded in the name of one of the minor’s parents or legal guardians.

All Nominations become the property of the Contest Entities and will not be acknowledged or returned. Nominations generated by a script, macro, or other automated means will be

disqualified. Nominations that are incomplete, garbled, corrupted, or unintelligible for any reason, including, but not limited to, computer or network malfunction or congestion, are void and will not be accepted. If there is a dispute as to the identity of an online Nominator who made a potentially winning Nomination, Sponsor will deem that the Nomination was made by the authorized account holder of the email address that submitted that Nomination in question. The "authorized account holder" is defined as the natural person to whom the email address is assigned by an Internet service provider, online service provider or other organization (e.g., business, educational institution, etc.) that is responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted email address. Except where prohibited by law or Sponsor's Privacy Policy, participation in the Contest and/or acceptance of a prize constitutes permission for Contest Entities to use the Nominator's and the Nominee's first name, last name, city, state, likeness, biographical information, statement, and/or voice for purposes of advertising, promotion, and publicity purposes in any and all media now or hereafter known throughout the world in perpetuity without additional compensation, notification, permission, or approval.

Essays must be the Nominator's sole and original work (that is, written only by the Nominator) and must be no more than three hundred (300) words and no less than (200) words in length. If an Essay exceeds three hundred (300) words, only the first three hundred (300) words of the Essay will be judged. Essay's less than (200) words will not be considered. Information stated in the Nomination must be truthful, current and correct and is subject to verification by Sponsor. By submitting an Essay, Nominator grants Contest Entities and those authorized by them permission to post, print, display or read the Essay on the Internet, in print media, and/or broadcast on television, radio or otherwise the Essay for public viewing/listening. Essays may be shortened, edited, modified, or otherwise changed at Sponsor's sole discretion, without the approval of the Nominator. Nominator warrants that such use by Contest Entities will not result in any liability to Contest Entities, and agrees to indemnify Contest Entities from and against any liability resulting from such use. Eligible Participants agree that Contest Entities shall have no obligation to copy, publish, display, or otherwise exploit the Essays. Essays must not include materials (language, phrases, quotations, etc.) belonging to or copyrighted by third parties; any such Essays containing third party materials will be disqualified. Essays must not have been previously published, performed, submitted in any competition or otherwise exhibited. Essays must only contain the first name of the Nominee and must not contain the name of any fictitious character(s). Essays must not contain the full name of any person, living or dead, unless such person has consented to such use. Essays must not contain any material that infringes upon any personal, proprietary, or any other right of any third party. Essays must not contain any obscene or otherwise objectionable material (as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion), references to alcoholic beverages, tobacco, drug paraphernalia, firearms, or any description or representation thereof. Essays must not contain any unsolicited or unauthorized advertising, promotional materials, or any other form of solicitation, and must not portray Contest Entities in a negative light (as determined by Contest Entities in their sole discretion). Essays must not contain any material that: (a) would give or threaten to give rise to criminal or civil liability; (b) encourages conduct that constitutes a criminal offense; or (c) encourages or provides instructional information about illegal activities.

Limit one (1) Nomination per Nominator and per email address during each Individual Contest Period.

If more than one Nomination is received from the same person or email address, only the first Nomination received will be considered and all subsequent Nominations will be disqualified. Essays that are not reasonably pertinent to the Judging Criteria (described below), as determined by Contest Entities in its sole discretion, or are otherwise in violation of these Official Rules will be disqualified.

PRIVACY: Any personal information supplied by Nominator and/or Nominee will be subject to Sponsor's Privacy Policy posted at: <http://www.nbcuniversal.com/privacy-spanish/>; and Nominators will have the opportunity to receive information from Sponsor and selected partners by checking the appropriate box(es). Doing so is optional and will not affect the chances of winning for the Nominee named in your Nomination. If, at any time, you no longer wish to receive materials from the Sponsor and selected partners, please go to their respective Privacy Policies and follow the procedures indicated.

JUDGING AND SELECTION OF WINNERS: Eligible Entries received during each Individual Contest period will be judged using the judging criterion fully described below.

Judging: On a rolling basis during Individual Contests dates outlines above, all eligible Nominations will be judged by representatives of the Contest Entities. Nominations will be judged based upon the following judging criteria: **1)** relevance to the theme (34 Points); **2)** originality (33 points); and **3)** commitment to the community (33 points) ("Judging Criteria") for a maximum possible total of one hundred (100) points. Ties will be broken as follows ("Tie Breaking Procedure"): In the event of a tie, the tied Nomination that received the most points for the criteria "relevance to the theme" will win the tie-breaker. In the event of a further tie, the tied Nomination that received the most points for the criteria "originality" points will win the tie-breaker. In the event of a further tie, the tied Nomination that received the most points in the criteria "commitment to the community" will win the tie-breaker. In the event of any remaining tie, the tied Nominations will be re-scored as above until the tie is broken. The Nominee featured in the Nomination that receives the highest overall score during the each Individual Contest Entry Period (or who wins in the Tie Breaking Procedure if there is a tie for the highest overall score) will be determined the Potential Winner ("Winner"), subject to confirmation of eligibility and compliance with these Official Rules.

NOTIFICATION OF WINNERS: On or around the dates indicated in the table above, the potential Winner ("Winner(s)") selected will be notified by Sponsor's representative. Sponsor's representative will make two (2) attempts within a period of two (2) days to notify the potential Winner at the phone number or email submitted at the time of Nomination. Potential Winner, or the parent or legal guardian if Winner is under the age of eighteen (18) years old, will be required to execute and return (via shipping service pre-paid by Sponsor) an Affidavit of Eligibility, Liability Release, Publicity Release (where legal) and any other documentation that Sponsor may require (collectively, "Contest Documents") within two (2) days of receipt of such notification. In addition to the Contest Documents, potential Winner may be asked to provide a copy of the Nominee's school-issued photo identification or other proof of being an active student in the Houston Independent School District within the prescribed time period. Noncompliance with this time period will result in disqualification, and the Nominee featured in next highest scoring Nomination submitted during the Individual Contest may be notified. By returning the completed Contest Documents, potential Winner attest to the authenticity and accuracy of the Nomination. If the potential Winners cannot be reached, if Nominee is found to be ineligible, if he/she cannot or does not comply with these Official Rules, and/or if her prize notification is returned as undeliverable, such potential Winner will be disqualified and the Winner featured in the next highest scoring Nomination may be notified as a Potential Winner.

WINNERS PRIZES: There will be one (1) Winner prizes ("Prize(s)") awarded to the Winner of each of the Individual Contest consisting of the following: one (1) check for one thousand dollars (\$1000.00). The check may take up to ninety (90) days to be issued. Each Winner may be recognized at an Event hosted by Contest Entities at a date and time to be determined and

mutually agreed upon. The Estimated Retail Value ("ERV") of each Winner Prize is one thousand dollars (\$1000.00). **The total ERV of all prizes is four thousand dollars (\$4000.00).** The actual retail value ("ARV") of each Prize may vary. Any difference between the ERV and ARV will not be awarded. For any prize with an ARV of six hundred dollars (\$600) or more, sponsors will provide a form 1099 from the U.S. Department of Revenue ("IRS") for the year to the Winner or to the parent's or legal guardian of the Winner, if he or she is under eighteen (18) years of age.

CONDITIONS: By entering the Contest, each Nominator and Nominee agrees for Nominator and Nominee and for Nominator's and Nominee's heirs, executors, and administrators (a) to release and hold harmless the Contest Entities and their respective officers, directors, employees, shareholders, representatives, prize providers and agents (collectively, "Released Parties") from any liability, illness, injury, death, loss, litigation, or damage that may occur, directly or indirectly, whether caused by negligence or not, from such Nominator's and Nominee's participation in the Contest and/or his/her acceptance, possession, use, misuse of, or inability to use, a prize (including any travel or activity related thereto); (b) to indemnify Released Parties from any and all liability resulting or arising from the Contest and to hereby acknowledge that Released Parties have neither made nor are in any manner responsible or liable for any warranty, representation, or guarantee, express or implied, in fact or in law, relative to a prize (or prize component), including express warranties provided exclusively by the prize supplier that are sent along with a prize; (c) if selected as the Winner, to the posting of Nominator's and Nominee's name on the Web Site and the use by Released Parties of such name, voice, image, photo, video recording, and/or likeness for publicity, promotional, and advertising purposes in any and all media now or hereafter known throughout the world in perpetuity without additional compensation, notification, permission or approval and, upon request, to the giving of consent, in writing, to such use; and (d) to be bound by these Official Rules and to waive any right to claim any ambiguity or error herein or in the Contest itself, and to be bound by all actions of the Sponsor, whose decisions are binding and final on all matters related to this Contest. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in disqualification from the Contest at Sponsor's sole discretion.

ADDITIONAL TERMS: Sponsor reserves the right to terminate the Contest or permanently disqualify from any promotion (including this one) any person they believe has intentionally violated these Official Rules. Any attempt to deliberately damage the Contest or operation thereof is unlawful and subject to legal action by Sponsor, who may seek damages and other remedies (including attorneys' fees) to the fullest extent permitted by law. Sponsor reserves the right to cancel, suspend, or modify the Contest should any computer virus, malfunction, or other cause corrupt the administration, security, or proper operation thereof. In the event of such cancellation, Sponsor reserves the right to select the Winner, as applicable, from among all eligible, non-suspect Entries received prior to the event requiring cancellation based on the Judging Criteria described above. Notice of cancellation, suspension, or modification will be posted on Web Site. The failure of Sponsor to comply with any provision of these Official Rules due to an act of God, hurricane, war, fire, riot, earthquake, terrorism, act of public enemies, actions of governmental authorities (excepting compliance with applicable codes and regulations), or other "force majeure" event will not be considered a breach of these Official Rules. Released Parties assume no responsibility for any injury or damage to Nominator's, Nominee's, or to any other person's computer and/or telephone relating to or resulting from entering or downloading materials or software in connection with the Contest. Released Parties are not responsible for telecommunications, network, electronic, technical, mechanical, or computer failures of any kind; for inaccurate transcription of Entry Information; for errors in any promotional, marketing, or prize notification or fulfillment materials or in these Official Rules; for any human or electronic error; or for Entries that are stolen, misdirected, garbled, delayed, lost, late, damaged, undelivered, or returned, or for lost, interrupted or unavailable network, server, Internet Service Provider (ISP), website, or other connections, availability or accessibility or miscommunications or failed computer, satellite,

telephone or cable transmissions, lines, or technical failure or jumbled, scrambled, delayed, or misdirected transmissions or computer hardware or software malfunctions. **The Contest Web Site was optimized to work with the most popular web browsers and may not properly work on mobile devices or tablet computers. It is recommended you access the Contest Web Site from a desktop or laptop computer.** Released Parties are not responsible for typographical, printing or other errors relating to or in connection with the Contest, including, without limitation, errors or difficulties which may occur in connection with the administration of the Contest, the processing or judging of Entries, the announcement of the Prize or in any Contest-related materials.

DISPUTES: THE CONTEST IS GOVERNED BY, AND WILL BE CONSTRUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH, THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, AND THE FORUM AND VENUE FOR ANY DISPUTE SHALL BE IN MIAMI, FLORIDA. IF THE CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM IS NOT OTHERWISE RESOLVED THROUGH DIRECT DISCUSSIONS OR MEDIATION, IT SHALL THEN BE RESOLVED BY FINAL AND BINDING ARBITRATION ADMINISTERED BY JAMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ITS STREAMLINED ARBITRATION RULES AND PROCEDURES OR SUBSEQUENT VERSIONS THEREOF ("JAMS RULES"). THE JAMS RULES FOR SELECTION OF AN ARBITRATOR SHALL BE FOLLOWED, EXCEPT THAT THE ARBITRATOR SHALL BE EXPERIENCED AND LICENSED TO PRACTICE LAW IN FLORIDA. ALL PROCEEDINGS BROUGHT PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH WILL BE CONDUCTED IN THE COUNTY OF MIAMI-DADE. THE REMEDY FOR ANY CLAIM SHALL BE LIMITED TO ACTUAL DAMAGES, AND IN NO EVENT SHALL ANY PARTY BE ENTITLED TO RECOVER PUNITIVE, EXEMPLARY, CONSEQUENTIAL, OR INCIDENTAL DAMAGES, INCLUDING ATTORNEY'S FEES OR OTHER SUCH RELATED COSTS OF BRINGING A CLAIM, OR TO RESCIND THIS AGREEMENT OR SEEK INJUNCTIVE OR ANY OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF.
